1. By enrolling the above named and described dog(s), I represent that I am the legal owner of the named dog(s) and I assume all risks, dangers, and responsibility for injuries to the named dog(s).
2. For the safety of all participants, their families and our community at large, we require all Lodge guests to be up to date on the following: Rabies, DHLPP, Influenza, Bordetella. Fecal is required for daycare participants. _____(initials)
3. Unaltered dogs over one year of age cannot attend daycare and/or be in group boarding. _____(initials)
4. Boarding very senior, chronically ill or otherwise debilitated pets requires extra care, which our caring and trained staff is happy to provide. However, special-needs pets, puppies and senior pets naturally have a higher risk of injury, stress-related illness, or exacerbation of any pre-existing condition. As such, by day/night boarding your special-needs pet, puppy, or senior pet with us you are waiving any claim for injury or illness experienced by your pet while in our care and that is not directly caused by the negligence or lack of care on the part of our staff. _____(initials)
5. All dogs must participate in a temperament test at The Lodge at Main Street Vet to attend Daycare. No dog may be admitted that shows signs of aggression. Owner further understands and agrees that in admitting Owner’s dog(s) to Daycare, Owner is representing to Daycare that Owners’ dog(s) is/are in good health and have not harmed, shown aggression, or exhibited any threatening behavior towards any person or other dog. If Owner is enrolling their dog(s) in daycare, Owner is representing that their dog has not shown aggression toward any person. Any dog demonstrating aggression or other behavior deemed unacceptable by Daycare staff may be required to leave Daycare. _____(initials)
6. Pet Owner understands and agrees that during normal dog play, Pet Owner’s dog may sustain injuries. All dog play is monitored by Daycare to avoid injury, but scratches, punctures, torn ligaments, and other injuries may occur despite the best supervision of our staff. Owner further understands and agrees that neither Daycare nor any of its employees, staff or volunteers, will be liable for any illness, injury, death, and /or escape of Owner’s Dog(s) provided that reasonable care and precautions are followed, and Owner hereby releases all of them of any liability of any kind whatsoever arising from or as a result of Owner’s dog(s) attending or participating at Daycare. _____(initials)
7. For the safety of your pet during their stay, we will remove personal items (collars, bandanas, clothing), which can cause injury during active play We provide easy-tear ID collars for each pet during their stay. _____(initials)

 Perform only emergency and supportive care. Notify me for permission to begin any other treatment.
